

**Interpretation**. The share of noble names among the top 0,1% highest inheritances in Paris dropped from 50% to 25% between 1780 and 1810, before rising to about 40%-45% during the period of censitory monarchies (1815-1848), and finally declining to about 10% in the late 19th century and early 20th century.
