

## The Inequality of Educational Investment: France 2020

Interpretation. Total public educational investment received during their studies (from kindergarten to university) by the students of the cohort reaching 20-year-old in 2020 will be about 120 k  $\in$  (i.e. approximately 15 years of studies for an average cost of 8000  $\in$  per year). Within this generation, the 10% of students receiving the smallest educational investment receive about 65-70 k  $\in$ , while the 10% receiving the most receive between 200 k  $\in$  and 300 k  $\in$ . Note: average costs per year of study in the French educational system in 2015-2020 rank from 5-6 k  $\in$  in kindergarten-primary to 8-10 k  $\in$  in secondary, 9-10 k  $\in$  in universities and 15-16 k  $\in$  in preparatory classes to grandes ecoles (etilite tracks).
