The Inequality of Educational Investment: France 2020


Interpretation.Total public educational investment received during their studies (from kindergarten to university) by the students of the cohort reaching 20 -year-old in 2020 will be about $120 \mathrm{k} €$ (i.e. approximately 15 years of studies for an average cost of $8000 €$ per year). Within this generation, the $10 \%$ of students receiving the smallest educational investment receive about 65-70 k€, while the $10 \%$ receiving the most receive between $200 \mathrm{k} €$ and $300 \mathrm{k} €$. Note: average costs per year of study in the French educational system in 2015-2020 rank from 5-6 k€ in kindergarten-primary to 8-10 k€ in secondary, 9-10 k€ in universities and 15-16 k€ in preparatory classes to grandes ecoles (etlite tracks).Sources and series: see piketty.pse.ens.fr/equality (figure 32)
