

Interpretation. Converted into 2019 purchasing power, the federal minimum wage increased from 4,25\$ per hour in 1950 to 7,25\$ in 2019 in the U.S., while the national minimum wage (Smig in 1950 and then Smic beginning in 1970) rose from 2,23€ per hour in 1950 to 10,03€ in 2019.
