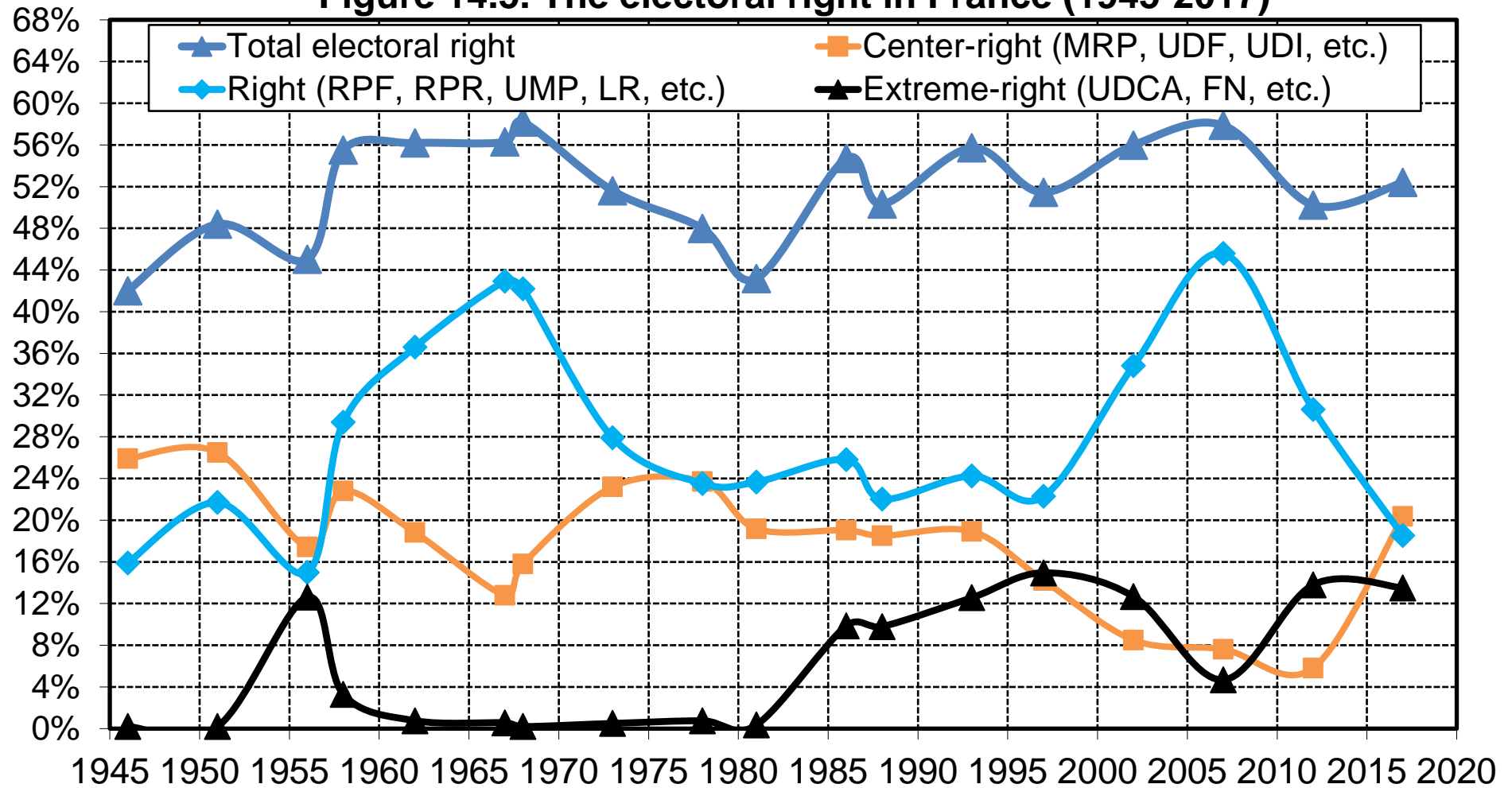


Figure 14.5. The electoral right in France (1945-2017)



Interpretation. The score obtained by right-wing parties (all parties from the center-right, right and extreme-right combined) has oscillated between 40% and 58% of the votes in the first rounds of legislative elections conducted in France over the 1945-2017 period.
