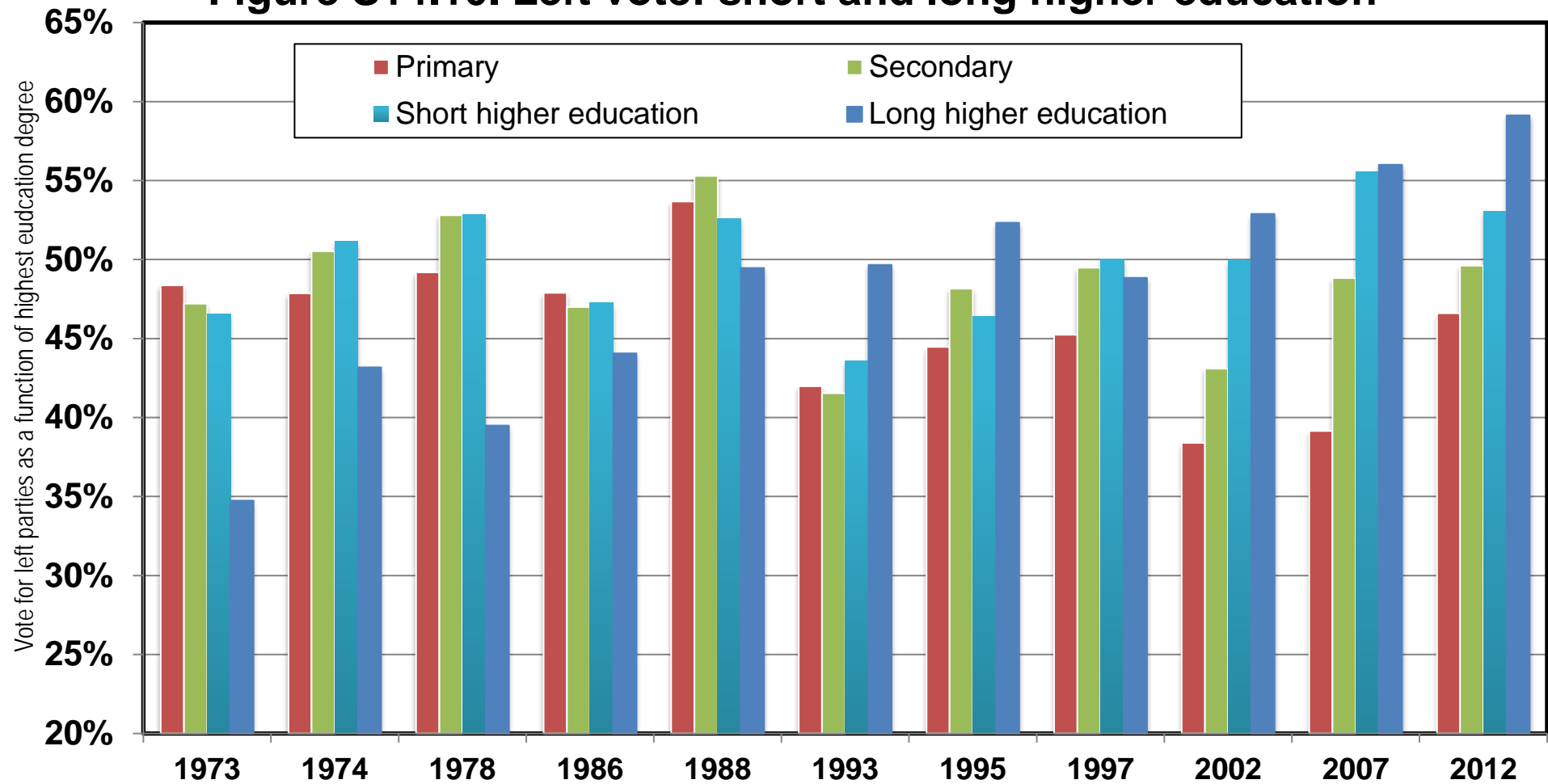


Figure S14.10. Left vote: short and long higher education



Interpretation. During the 1970s, vote for left parties (socialists-communists-radicals-greens) was higher among voters with short higher education degrees (degrees in two or three years after high school) than among voters with long higher education degrees (degrees in four years or more).
