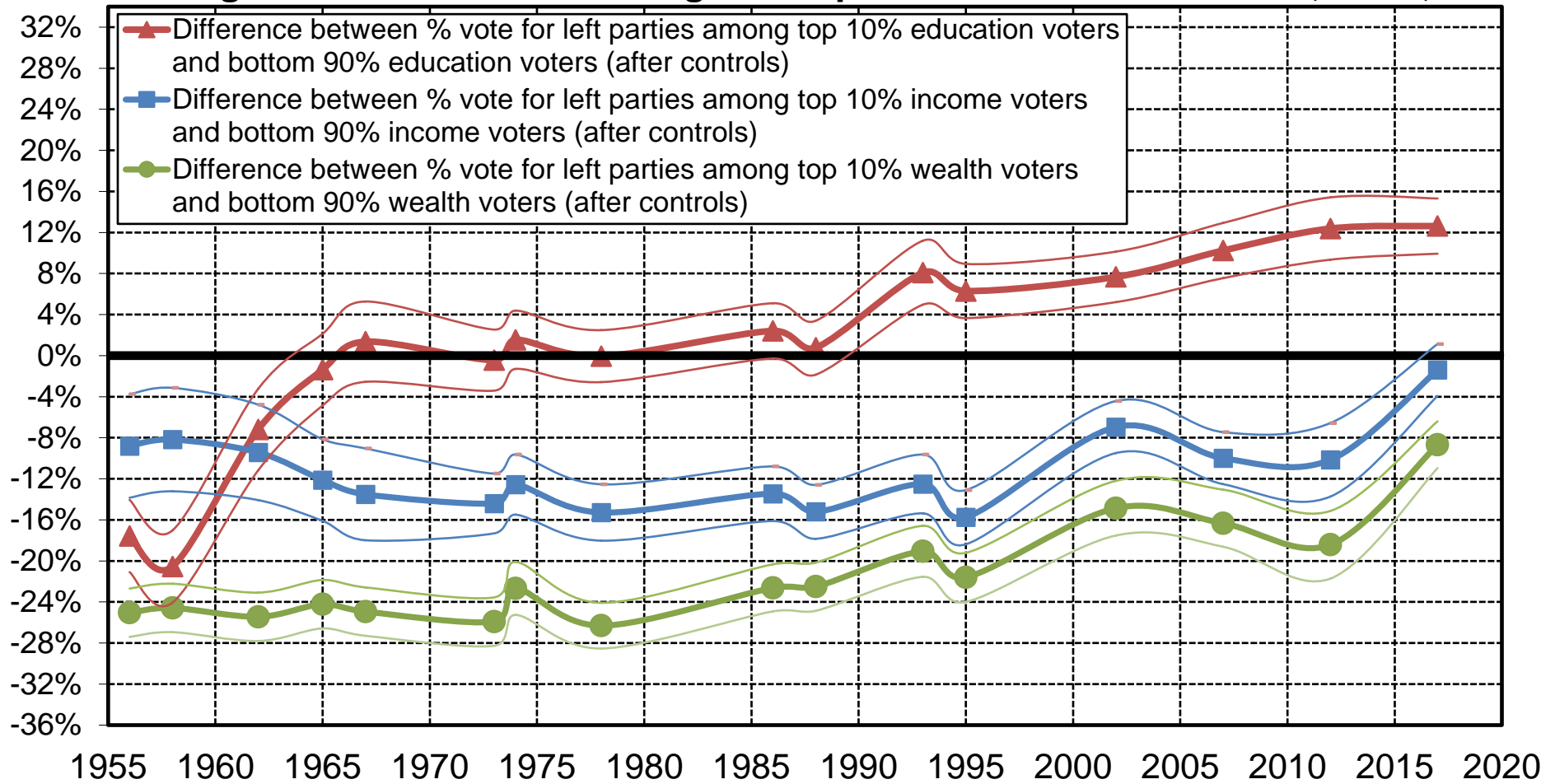


Figure S14.1c. Social cleavages and political conflict in France (variants)
